We will leave church at 8:30 a.m. and return at 3:30 p.m. Anchor House provides efficiency apartments, especially for those with Section 8 vouchers and veterans who otherwise are unable to find housing. They have 42 rooms on two levels. There is a community or shared dining room and kitchen as well as a courtyard. At this point we plan to help paint drywall and lay Vinyl plank flooring in community areas.

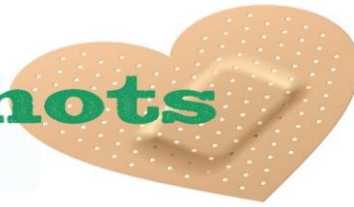
